

## CALL UP POLICY

The Call Up Policy allows teams to bring up players from the division below to support teams in order to address a shortage of players.

1. Players may be called up from the division below ONLY.
  2. A team may call up enough players to allow three (3) spares (e.g. U7 to U11 will be allowed six (6) team players, plus a goalie and three (3) call up players, U14 and U18 will be allowed ten (10) team players, plus a goalie and three (3) call up players).
  3. Players who are already playing up in a higher division under the terms of the Play Up Policy are not eligible to be called up.
  4. Players may be called up a maximum of eight (8) times during the regular season.
  5. Players called up to play as a goalie must play goal for the duration of the game and must be identified as such on the game sheet. Games played as a goalie will not be counted in the five (5) game allotment.
  6. If more players arrive and the team has arranged for "Call Up Players" all players will be played fairly in the game.
  7. Prior to the start of the game the Coach is to notify the referee to add the "Call Up Players" names to the game sheet and both Coaches are to initial the game sheet.
  8. Coaches are encouraged to identify players that they may need to call up prior to each game.
  9. Coaches are responsible for texting or emailing the convenor the names of the players and the game they played in, immediately after the game.
  10. It is mandatory for all Coaches to follow the Call Up Policy, and the P.D.S.A. Executive may discipline if the policy is not adhered to.
